Game Day Fields & Protocols

Coaches, Managers, Parents, Opponents, and Fans,

We feel incredibly lucky to be able to kick off this season of Travel soccer, despite the many restrictions and closures brought on by the pandemic. With that in mind, we need to protect our soccer community and are putting forth new protocols and guidelines for game days at our fields. These should be shared with our GFR Travel families as well as with our opponents who will come to play games on our fields.

Everyone's cooperation is <u>vital</u> to the success of the season. For the benefit of our children, let's kick it off in the safest way possible! We wish your team all the best this season.

GAME DAY Protocols:

- GFR players will have their temperature taken upon arrival at the field. Any player who has a temperature greater than 100.4°F and/or is exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 will not be allowed to participate in the match and will be asked to leave the area immediately.
- All players (substitutes) sitting on the bench or standing/sitting in the team area during the match must wear masks and maintain physical distance to the extent possible. Coaches will wear masks at all times.
- Players may not share water, snacks, or any personal equipment.
- There will be no handshakes, fist bumps or other contact with the opposing team after the match.
- Teams will have a maximum of 10 minutes to evacuate the field after the match. Oncoming teams must wait 15 minutes after the end of the previous game or until the bench is completely cleared, with the previous team off the field before entering.
- Notify the opposing club should any child test positive for COVID-19 within 10 days after the match.


SPECTATORS:

- No spectators (including siblings) may enter or be seated near the team/player area and must maintain a 25yard distance from the team/player area. The spectator area will be across the field from the players (unless
 otherwise noted in the field diagrams), and spectators must keep a physical distance of at least 6 feet from
 others outside their household.
- It is **MANDATORY** for all spectators to wear masks for the entire match and while entering and exiting the field.
- All spectators may only enter the field once the players and coaches have entered. It is recommended that spectators remain in their vehicles until 5 minutes before the scheduled kickoff time.
- Please avoid forming crowds at the entrance/exit to fields. No social gatherings!

FIELD: LAKE FAIRFAX 1 AND 4 (Turf) ADDRESS: Lake Fairfax Park, 1400 Lake Fairfax Drive, Reston, VA 20190

Upon arriving at the multi-use complex, follow the signs for the soccer fields.

- Field #4 is on the right on top of the hill and just before the large parking lot
- Field #1 is at the far end of the parking lot
- There is at least one portable toilet at the entrance to each field
- The team/player area will be at the stationary benches/bleachers.

FIELD: GREAT FALLS NIKE PARK Field 7A & B (Turf) -- <u>SMALL-SIDED GAMES</u> ADDRESS: 1111 Utterback Store Rd, Great Falls, VA 22066

Additional Notes for this field:


- There are two portable toilets at the entrance to the field and additional portable toilets are located at the beginning of the parking lot close to the adjacent grass field.
- Teams that arrive before the end of a prior game can use the adjacent grass field for warmup.
- For small-sided games, home players will sit in the center between fields facing their playing field. Visiting players will sit across the field.
- The spectator area will be <u>outside</u> the fence along the perimeter of the field. Spectators must keep a physical distance of at least 6 feet from others outside their household.



FIELD: GREAT FALLS NIKE PARK Field 7 (Turf) <u>FULL-SIDED GAMES</u> ADDRESS: 1111 Utterback Store Rd, Great Falls, VA 22066

Additional Notes for this field:

- There are two portable toilets at the entrance to the field.
- There are additional portable toilets at the beginning of the parking lot close to the adjacent grass field.
- The team/player area will be at the stationary bench/bleacher area. Spectators will remain <u>outside</u> the fence and must maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet from those outside their household.
- Teams that arrive before the end of a prior game can use the adjacent grass field for warmup.



FIELD: Ken Lawrence Park Field 1 (Turf)

ADDRESS: 8008 Jones Branch Drive, Tysons, VA 22102

Additional Notes for this field:

- There are portable toilets near the spectator entrance at the back of the field.
- Spectators should enter through the back and remain on that side of the field throughout the match.

FIELDS: Langston Hughes Middle School and South Lakes High School ADDRESS: 11401 Ridge Heights Rd, Reston, VA 20191

Additional Notes for the field:

• Due to construction at Langston Hughes Middle School, please note that the visiting spectator area is contained to a limited space behind the goal nearest the tennis courts. It is imperative that parents wear masks while in this area and maintain a safe distance.
